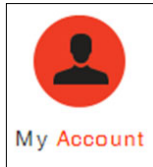


## PATRON ACCESS AT MCLINC

## USING PATRON ACCESS TO CHECK YOUR LIBRARY ACCOUNT

Patron access displays your registration information, reserve requests, items currently checked out, and fines and fees charged to your library account as well as your Reading History, if activated.

**To view your Registration information:**

Click **My Record** on the left.

**To view your Reserve Requests:**

Click **Requests**

**To cancel** one or more reserve requests, check the box next to the title, then click the button **Cancel Selected** or **Cancel All**.

**To view items currently checked out:** Click **Items Out**

**To view your Fines and Fees:**

Click **Fines and Fees**

**Pay fines and lost book charges online.**

Minimum payment is \$5. MCLINC accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover.

A \$1 fee will be charged to help cover the costs to provide and maintain this service.
