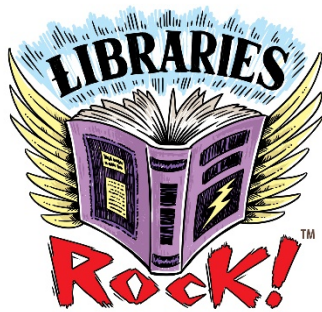

Encourage your children to join Summer Quest, our exciting new summer learning program! In addition to reading, children in kindergarten through entering grade six are invited to grow and explore through hands-on activities involving science, art, music, technology, and more. Each child will receive a reading/activity log that can be used to earn prizes and a free book.

The Library offers a summer read-to-me program for preschoolers through entering kindergarten. Each child will receive a log and stickers to keep track of their reading. Participants may also earn a prize and free book.

Bring your children in to register starting **Friday, June 15**. (Those who have signed up through school do not need to re-register.) Rewards may be claimed through **Friday, August 31**.
